**Criteria for Granting Equivalent Activity or CEUs**

Equivalent Activity Units or CEUs may be granted if they support an Individual's Professional Development Plan (IPDP), which will be based on the Ohio Department of Education's *Teacher Education and Licensure Standards* (Administrative Code Chapter 3301-24). Equivalent Activity Units or CEUs may not be granted for what is part of your job expectation. Balanced professional growth is dependent upon a variety of experiences, including:

- Courses taken at accredited colleges or universities
- Workshops
- Building/District projects
- Individual projects (concrete evidence of project completion required)

Under the standards for license renewal, 18 professional development CEUs (or six {6} semester hours) are required.

- One (1) semester hour = three (3) CEUs
- One (1) quarter hours = two (2) CEUs
- 10 contact hours = one (1) CEU for workshop/project experiences

CEUs will be granted according to how they support an individual's IPDP in one or more of the following areas:

- subject matter
- student learning
- diversity of learners
- planning instruction
- instructional strategies
- learning environment
- communication
- assessment
- student support
